

The MA American Legion Softball League is sanctioned by the Department MA and abides by The American Legion, Department of MA policies, principles and rules. Offering a program for high school softball players that will help teams develop during the summer, and as with baseball, keep teams together. Legion Softball will also further build local pride and sense of community.



Does a post have to sponsor a Legion Softball Team?

It is required for a Legion Softball team to be sponsored by a Legion Post. Posts/Legion Family and other organizations may share sponsorship or another organization/business may co-sponsor such as a business or recreational league. A self-funded team may be affiliated in name only with a sponsoring Post. In this case, the Post provides its name and support for affiliation but does not provide financial assistance or cover any team expenses.

funding is very important in mainiaining a healthy softball program while keeping player fees to a minimum. Contacting your local Legion Post for sponsorship could yield a financial donation or assistance in fundrainsing.



In order for a Post to successfully sponsor a team, it is important for the coaching staff and Legionnaires to work together and to share the various duties and responsibilities.

Each coach, manager or person involved with the team must complete a background check at a cost of \$14 each.

Abuse Training


Each individual will receive a link for a free Abuse Training which takes about 30 minutes, and the link will remain active for two weeks.

No Substitutions

If an individual has previously undergone background screening through/for another organization, those results may not be substituted.

All teams must wear matching uniforms (tops and bottoms). The Massachusetts American Legion Softball patch must be displayed on the left chest or left sleeve.

Uniforms must display the sponsoring Post number somewhere on the jersey and player numbers on the back.

These patches can be obtained from digital files for sublimated jerseys.


Deadlines

Frequently Asked Questions



Does our team need to be sponsored by an American Legion Post?

You can be sponsored by an American Legion Post, Auxiliary, SAL or the American Legion Riders. A Business or softball League may Co-Sponsor, as long as it's approved by the Massachusetts American Legion Softball Fastpitch Committee. If you are a post or a softball team looking to be paired up let us know. We can assist in matching Teams with Local Legion Sponsorships.

What uniform requirements will there be?

The Massachusetts American Legion Softball Logo will be required to be on the jersey top. This logo needs to be on the left chest area or left sleeve. The patch may be sublimated in the jersey (with Massachusetts Legion Softball prior approval) in the required area. Contact malegionladyfastpitch@gmail.com for patches. Teams must be in matching jersey tops and bottoms.

Can I just Volunteer in some way?

Yes, Legion Fastpitch can always use your help. Volunteers can serve in a variety of ways, ranging from statisticians to serving Gatorade during games. You can also reach out to your local Legion team and volunteer directly with them.

Are you required to be related to a Veteran to play?

No, it is open to any girl who falls within the age group bracket can participate.

Who schedules games?

Teams will schedule their own local regular season games. Schedules and game Scores must be recorded and reported to Mass legion Softball. Regional & State Tournaments will be scheduled by Mass legion Softball.

Frequently Asked Questions



What costs are associated with having a team?

IThe cost of a season can vary dramatically depending on your teams' access to equipment and fields. Some costs your team may incur include Game Ball Softballs, Equipment for Practices, First Aid Kit, Field fees, Insurance, Uniforms, Umpires, the \$150 Legion Fee, and the \$14 Background check fee per coach.

What is the cost per player?

Teams can decide on individual player costs based on their sponsorship, fundraising, and season expenses. Some leagues may charge no fee while others need to charge something. The goal is to keep this as low cost as possible.

What are the age requirements to be eligible for participation in the 2025 season?

Athletes must be in the 8th, 9th, 10th, or 12th grade as of the academic year and under the age of 19 as of June 1. All athletes must also meet at least one of the criteria below:

- A full-time resident of Massachusetts
- A full-time student at a recognized Massachusetts Middle or High School

How is transportation coordinated?



Team will coordinate transportation individually whether it be parent/team transportation or bussing.

Who is in charge of umpires for games?

Home teams are responsible for booking Umpire through their local Umpire Association. Umpires cost would be an even split between home team and away team regardless of whose field it is being played on. (For regular season play).

Can players participate in travel ball and Legion Softball at the same time?

Yes, players ARE NOT committed to play only Legion Softball. However, each Legion team cannot exceed 5 players from an individual travel program or team. The goal of Legion Softball is to also reach the higher caliber athletes who may not be able to afford travel softball. They must play 10 regular season game to qualify for their regional tournament. You would play in a double-elimination regional tournament and if you placed in the top two spots you then would qualify for the State tournament at no extra registration cost to your program. Potentially getting two tournaments for the price of one.

Frequently Asked Questions

Softball Fastpitch Insurance?

Each team must have insurance to participate. You may pick your own carrier. The Insurance purchased by the team will be adjusted to include 'Additional Insured' which will provide the Post or Sponsor additional insured status.

Who is required to do Background Checks?

Annual background screening is required for each coach, manager or person involved with the team must complete a background check at a cost of \$14 each, they will also receive a link for a Free Abuse Training which takes about 30 minutes to complete. This will be completed through Protect Youth Sports. If an individual has prevuously undergone a background screening of any kind, those results may not be substituted.

What does the season schedule look like?

Regular Season (start after High School play is done, usually end of June) teams will play 10 games. Teams must field (9) nine players to start each game.

How many classes/divisions will there be?

All teams will compete at the Varsity level. As the program grows, we hope to offer the Jv. level.

What will postseason play look like?

Playoffs will be overseen by the Massachusetts American Legion Softball Committee. District Tournaments may require more travel for some than others, depending on the number of teams registered as well as the location of those registered teams. When we have enough teams register in different areas of Massachusetts, District Tournaments will be scheduled. District winners will advance to Regionals.

Regional Tournaments bring together the winners of District play. If there are not enough teams statewide for Districts, a single Regional Tournament may serve as the postseason.

Where do I find a Coach?

You must find your own coach. Check with your Schools, Recreational softball leagues, Churches, Parents, Friends, and Other Teams to find a Coach for your team. If you are a post and need assistance finding softball coach, please reach out. It is our goal to introduce the "Softball" community to the "American Legion" Family and hopefully pair some up to start their own teams.
